*First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final:*

**VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2022**

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

**VHS Regional Final qualification.** All competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership, this **MUST** be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitor's responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 30th September – 2nd October 2022. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

## TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes Affiliation No 22/1607/3/STQ

Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Competitors do not need to know the breeding of their cob, but they must meet breed standard to enter the class.

Stallions – All stallions (4 years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Colts/Stallions three-year-old and over **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead.

Existing TGCA members that qualify MUST present their qualification card to the judge in the ring and MUST have already completed the cobs name and registration number prior to judge signing.

Non-members that qualify should receive a non-members qualification card from the judge in the ring and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.

Quest for a Star Championship Inc Youngstock Quest for a Star- Traditional Gypsy Cobs  
1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule.

ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship, if exhibit already has their Quest for a Star Qualification in particular section, they should be ask stand aside to allow members that have not yet qualified.

Membership card and Member's qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Traditional Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Traditional Gelding.

The judge will award this within the classes/championship.

## **The Showing Register (TSR)**

### **TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals**

This show is a qualifier for the 2022 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class.

Competitors MUST have their qualification record sheet signed by judge/steward/secretary; sheets are available FREE from the TSR website.

**Class 1:** Novice Show Handler – any horse/pony with a novice handler – must be the handler's first year in the showing ring

**Class 2:** Open In Hand Hunter Horse/Pony – any type/age/height NCPA & TSR

**Class 3:** Open In Hand Cob Horse/Pony – any type/age/height NCPA TSR TGCA

**Class 4:** Open In Hand Coloured Horse/Pony - any type/age/height NCPA TSR TGCA

**Class 5:** In Hand Shetland Pony Class – any type/age/height NCPA TSR

**Class 6:** In Hand Mixed Breeds Mountain & Moorland, Registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books any type/age/height NCPA TSR

**Class 7:** Veteran In-Hand, Combined Age Class (15 years and over). To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. VHS NCPA TSR

# RIDDEN CLASSES

**Horse Ring – Classes to start no earlier than 1.00pm**

**Judge:** Mrs Vicky Goldsbrough

**THE JUDGE WILL NOT RIDE ANY HORSES IN THESE CLASSES**

**Riders should be a suitable height/weight for the horse/pony**

**Class 8:** Open Ridden Hunter Horse/Pony - any type/age/height NCPA & TSR

**Class 9:** Open Ridden Cob Horse/Pony – any type/age/height NCPA TSR TGCA

**Class 10:** Open Ridden Coloured Horse/Pony - any type/age/height NCPA TSR TGCA

**Class 11:** Open Ridden Mixed Breeds Mountain & Moorland, Registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books any type/age/height. NCPA TSR

**Class 12:** Veteran Ridden, Combined Age Class (15 years and over). To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height. VHS NCPA TSR

**Class 13:** Ridden Competition Horse or Pony - any type/age/height NCPA & TSR

**Class 14:** Open ridden TGCA. 4 years old and over, any height. TGCA qualifier.

**Class 15:** Open Riding Horse, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. NCPA & TSR

# UNAFFILIATED CLASSES

**Main Showground Ring - Starting at 10:00am.**

**Judge:** Mrs Sara Dace-Hughes

Open to all horses & ponies & riders of all ages. Horses and ponies will not be judged on conformation.

Classes are open to plaited and unplaited Horses/Ponies

Stallions to be kept under control at ALL times and not to be led or ridden by children under 16 years.

**Class 16:** Handy horse/pony. To be judged on time over a course of hazards and obstacles, failure to negotiate any obstacle will invoke time penalties. Competitors in Handy Pony classes are advised to come to the Main Ring as soon as possible to give time to walk the course. Ponies must be four years and over.

**Class 17:** Equitation class. Judged on style, control and effectiveness in all three paces.

**Class 18:** Fancy Dress – Mounted or led

**Class 19:** Horse or Pony the judge would most like to take home.
